CIT/CIP Program Coordinator

NAMI Fox Valley, the local affiliate of the National Alliance on Mental Illness, seeks a part time (15 hours/week) Program Coordinator. The CIT/CIP Program Coordinator is primarily responsible for the development, enhancement, and implementation of the CIT (Crisis Intervention Team) law enforcement training and the CIP (Crisis Intervention Partner) training for corrections and related fields. This Coordinator works in close partnership with the NAMI Fox Valley Police Specialist and the CIT/CIP steering committee. Additional duties include, but are not limited to, preparation and distribution of the quarterly CIT newsletter, maintenance of the CIT webpage, promotion and presentations at conferences and community events, participation in the planning process of the Outagamie County Mental Health Court, and membership on the Outagamie County Coordinating Council Committee.

The successful candidate will possess a Bachelor's Degree in a field related to the shared missions of NAMI Fox Valley and the CIT program, such as social work, human services, education, or criminal justice. S/he will have at least two years' experience with project management and implementation. The successful candidate will possess a professional demeanor and communication style, excellent customer service skills, and the organizational skills necessary to plan high-quality trainings for law enforcement and other professionals. This Coordinator should possess a strong understanding of the issues surrounding living with mental illness, the system of mental health care in the Fox Valley, and the issues related to the interaction of mental health consumers and law enforcement.
