### **Crisis Intervention Team training (CIT) for law enforcement in Wisconsin**

What is CIT? CIT is specialized training for volunteer police officers on how to work with the mentally ill. It includes training on all facets of brain disease including depression, bi-polar, schizophrenia and anxiety disorders as well as medications, developmental disabilities, post traumatic stress, and cultural issues. There is also discussion on topics including suicide assessment, dual diagnosis, and the impact on the law, the courts and the prison system. Special emphasis is placed on dealing with excited delirium syndrome and the principals of de-escalation when working with someone in crisis. The week is capped off with a day of scenario-based training involving actors in typical situations that officers respond to and where mental illness is a factor.

#### **What is the origin of CIT?**

CIT was started in 1988 by than Lt. Sam Cochran of the Memphis Tennessee Police Department. To read more about CIT and the Memphis Police Department go to <http://www.memphispolice.org/Crisis%20Intervention.htm>.

CIT was developed in conjunction with Dr. Randy Dupont of the University of Memphis. To read more about this partnership with The University of Memphis go to their link at <http://cit.memphis.edu/>.

The partnership between law enforcement and mental health has been studied in a very comprehensive way. One of the leading reports on this partnership is called the **Consensus Project** and was conducted and completed in 2002 by the Council of State Governments. But Tennessee isn't the only state that has a firm grip on CIT. Ohio has one of the broadest approaches to implementing CIT at a statewide level in the country. ## What is Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Training in Wisconsin?

Brain disease or chemical imbalances of the brain, sometimes referred to as mental illness, are the number one disability in America. It affects one out of four families. Given that fact, it comes as no surprise that 60% of most mental health consumers, people who live daily with a brain disorder, report having contacts with law enforcement.

It is commonly the policy of police departments across the country that persons displaying signs and or symptoms of mental illness or severe emotional distress shall be afforded dignified treatment. The safety of the consumer, the officer or the public will not be compromised in this effort.

Today, law enforcement's most efficient tool at achieving this mission is through the use of the "Memphis Model" of the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) approach. The Appleton Police Department began implementation of CIT in June 2004. The CIT approach is a community effort enjoining both the police and the community together for common goals of safety, understanding and service to the mentally ill and their families. CIT is recognized by Wisconsin's DHFS as a "Best Practice" for crisis intervention.

In Appleton, the anchor agency behind the CIT Initiative is NAMI Fox Valley, ([www.namifoxvalley.org](http://www.namifoxvalley.org)) an affiliate of NAMI, the National Alliance on Mental Illness. This partnership has been critical in developing a more intelligent understanding and safe approach to mental crisis incidents.

CIT officers are patrol officers who volunteer to receive special training in working with persons with mental illness. In addition to handling their regular patrol duties, these officers are called upon to respond to crisis calls that place officers face to face with complex issues relating to mental illness. The specialized training the CIT officers receive is under the instructional supervision of mental health experts and providers, family advocates, consumer groups and experienced APD CIT officers. Because of the training, CIT officers can, with confidence, offer a more humane and calm approach to the crisis resolution.

But ***CIT is more than just training.*** CIT is about doing the right thing for the right reasons. CIT recognizes a special population that deserves special care, treatment and service. It takes a special person to become a CIT officer. CIT officers help identify persons in need of community services, assists in getting them connected to those resources and works at helping to keep them connected. These CIT officers play a key role in reducing the likelihood of physical confrontations and enhance the opportunity for better mental health care.

### **There are many benefits to the CIT Initiative:**

- ⌘ Reduced risk of injuries to consumers, public and officers
- ⌘ Reduction in repeat contacts with mental health consumers
- ⌘ Reduction of criminalization of those persons with mental illness that come in contact with the criminal justice system
- ⌘ Enhanced working relationships with mental health care providers in the community
- ⌘ Increased involvement of the families and friends of the mental health consumers
- ⌘ Reduction in civil commitments through diversion to safe & less restrictive settings
- ⌘ Reduction in the costs of overall services through better utilization of said services and diversion to less costly services

By bringing CIT to Wisconsin, CIT officers are giving mental health consumers and their families a sense of dignity. This dignity generates a new respect and outlook on both law enforcement and the mental health care system. This in turn will offer them something that most consumers and their families can always use more of, Hope.

NAMI Fox Valley, in conjunction with mental health care professionals from throughout Wisconsin, as well as select APD CIT officers, holds two 40-hour CIT training sessions each year. The thirteen sessions held thus far have graduated more than 300 officers from across the State. The initiative to bring CIT to Wisconsin did not go unnoticed. NAMI Wisconsin, located in Madison, recognized the Appleton Police Department in 2005 with an Educators Award at the 2005 State NAMI Conference. In addition, the Governor's Office recognized Michael Woody, a retired Lieutenant from the Akron Ohio Police Department, for helping to bring CIT to WI. In 2010 NAMI Wisconsin once again recognized APD by awarding the "Protect and Serve" award to the department. For their dedication, Karen Aspenson, Executive Director at NAMI Fox Valley, and Sgt. John Wallschlaeger of the Appleton Police Department were recognized by CIT International at the annual conference.

The CIT Initiative has expanded beyond Appleton. In January 2006, the Milwaukee Police Department held its first ever CIT training session, graduating 39 officers. They have since held several more sessions. Milwaukee PD sent officers to both Memphis and Appleton in building their CIT Initiative. They will be conducting sessions to achieve their department goal of 25% of officers trained. A "suburban departments" training session that was initially started at the Milwaukee County Sheriffs Departments has shifted to NAMI Waukesha. They held their second CIT session in May 2011.

LaCrosse held its first ever CIT training Session in October 2006 graduating 19 CIT officers from the area. Four of the people associated with organizing CIT

training in LaCrosse are graduates of the Appleton CIT training. Since 2006, LaCrosse has trained more than 75 officers / deputies from around the county.

They plan on continuing to host sessions in conjunction with the local mental Health Association and welcome officers from outside the area.

Racine NAMI, in conjunction with the Racine Police Department, launched its first ever "Memphis Model" CIT Session in May of 2009. Since 2009 they have graduated more than 75 officers and deputies from across the county.

Kenosha NAMI, in conjunction with the Kenosha Police Department, hosted its first CIT sessions with two classes in 2010. They have graduated more than 40 officers and deputies from across the county.

**Crisis Intervention Partner (CIP)** is also being offered at Appleton, Racine, Kenosha and Waukesha locations. CIP is modeled after the training started by Milwaukee NAMI for hospital staff. It is designed for the peripheral personnel that assist the Police as first responders. This would include but not be limited to corrections, dispatchers, EMS, teachers, ER staff, company nurses, library staff, bus drivers, just to name a few.
